Since then the event has gained tremendous support from Central Ohioans, attracting hundreds of local community celebrities, volunteers and supporters from various corporations throughout Central Ohio.

This year's event will continue the legacy of former Ohio State Buckeye and Oakland Raider great Jack Tatum. Jack passed away in 2010 from complications of diabetes. The event has raised nearly \$1 million to support the agency and this year we will continue to honor Jack's memory and to celebrate the storied history of Buckeye-Wolverine rivalry.

The event will include dinner, live and silent auctions, and the main program featuring a panel discussion about the game and rivalry with former players and coaches from Ohio State University and the University of Michigan. In addition, there will be an autograph session to give all attendees the opportunity to meet the players and coaches.
